Jennifer also gave her input in the form of positive affirmations and motivation. The valedictory ceremony ended at 3:30 PM with the National Anthem.

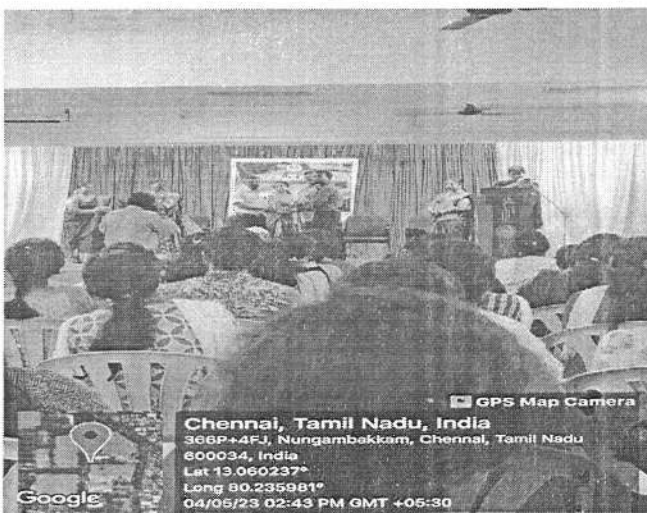
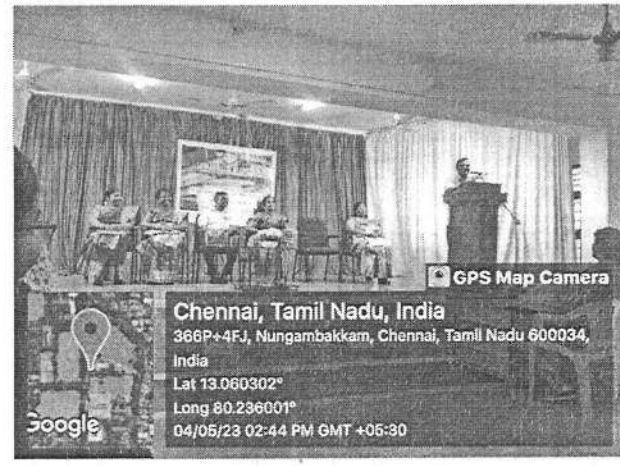
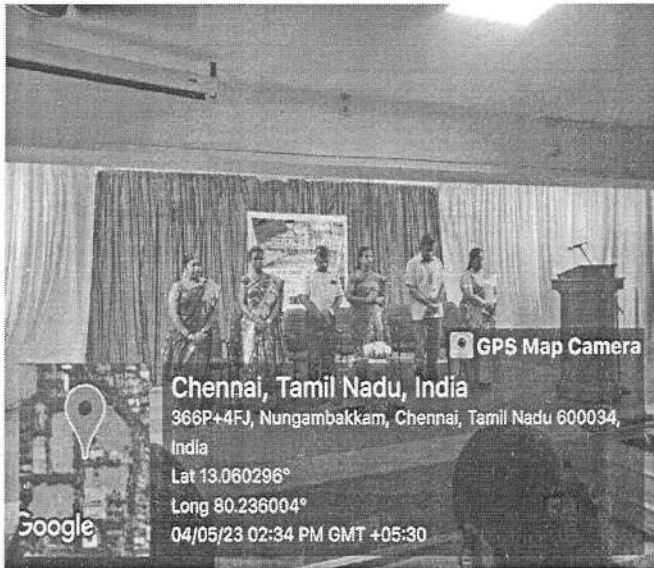


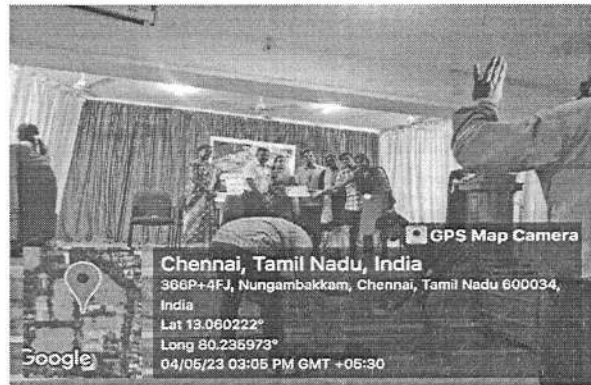
