He further earned his Ph.D. from the prestigious Anna University, focusing his cutting-edge research on Artificial Intelligence implementation for Natural Resource Management. Rev. Dr. Wenisch has held numerous leadership positions across premier institutions. His administrative legacy includes serving as the Principal of Loyola College, Vettavalam, Director of LICET, Chennai, and Dean of Administration at LIBA, Chennai. He has also served as Vice Principal and Treasurer at Loyola College, Mettala, and Head of the Department of Computer Science & Applications at Loyola College, Chennai.

	His global exposure spans international teaching in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, and theological studies at Hekima College in Nairobi, Kenya. He has travelled and lived across multiple countries, including the USA, Germany, France, the Netherlands, and the UAE. As a prolific scholar, Rev.
